PREPARATION OF PUBLICATIONS

The LISTO project is moving from action to delivery. Our consortium is preparing two publications. The first one will present a quantitative and qualitative analysis of the WP 2 activities: University-Industry cooperation in Latin America: Lessons learned from applying the AIMday methodology. The second one will share our experience of developing and testing an International Virtual Classroom. The title of the book with a lot of practical advise: Entrepreneurial Virtual Classroom Handbook: an interdisciplinary approach from a European and Latin American collaboration. Both publications are forthcoming in 2020 and will be available in English, Spanish and Portuguese.
